Scope of Work: The work required for this project includes providing all labor, equipment, and materials necessary for paving, general civil, fencing and rail modifications, alterations, additions, and repairs when requested by the Engineer on Port of Tacoma property. The Port does not guarantee a certain amount of work. The work will be assigned by Task Orders; each Task Order will address the scope of work and time of completion, and shall be performed in accordance with the Contract Documents and Task Order provisions.

Contract Amount: Contract amount is **Not to Exceed (NTE) \$600,000.00**, plus Washington State Sales Tax.

Sealed Bid Date/Time/Location: Bids will be received at the Reception Desk, Port Administration Office, **One Sitzcum Plaza, Tacoma, Washington 98421** until **2:00 PM** on **Thursday, April 24, 2014** at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Pre-Bid Conference and Site Tour: No Pre-Bid Conference or Site Visit will be held for this bid.

Bid Bond: Each bid must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bid Security in an amount equal to five (5%) percent of the NTE contract amount (\$600,000.00).
